5. Situation Summary and Health and Safety Briefing

Visitation and funeral services for Trooper Stein Davis will take place on March 4, 2026, at **Robeson Community College (Building 15), located at 5160 Fayetteville Rd., Lumberton, NC 28360. Visitation will be held from 1000 hours until 1200 hours, followed by the funeral service beginning at 1400 hours, with interment immediately following at Meadowbrook Cemetery.

The event is expected to attract approximately 2,000 attendees, including family members, members of the law enforcement and emergency services community, and the public. Due to the anticipated attendance and ceremonial procession, significant traffic management, roadway closures, and coordinated escort operations will be required throughout the day.

The North Carolina State Highway Patrol will provide a primary escort for the Davis family from their residence to Robeson Community College. Trooper Davis will also be escorted from the funeral home to Robeson Community College prior to the service. Assisting agencies including the Lumberton Police Department, Robeson County Sheriff's Office, and Lumberton Fire Department will support the escort and funeral operations by controlling traffic and managing key intersections along the predetermined procession route.

Today's operations involve high-visibility traffic control, roadway closures, staging apparatus, and extended personnel assignments. All personnel are reminded that safety is our top priority while honoring this event.

1. Traffic & Roadway Safety

- Always wear **ANSI/ISEA 107 compliant high-visibility vests** when operating on or near roadways.
- Use proper apparatus positioning to create a safe work zone (block to the left when possible).
- Maintain situational awareness for civilian traffic, emergency vehicles, and pedestrian movement.
- Do not turn your back to moving traffic.
- Follow unified command directions for all roadway shutdowns and reopening.

2. Apparatus Placement & Movement

- Set parking brakes and deploy wheel chocks when appropriate.
- Avoid backing without a spotter.
- Keep access lanes open for procession movement and emergency contingencies.
- Maintain clear radio communication before moving apparatus.

3. Heat / Cold / Environmental Considerations

- Dress appropriately for weather conditions.
- Stay hydrated and rotate personnel as needed.
- Monitor for signs of heat stress, cold stress, or fatigue.

4. Professional Conduct & Awareness

- Maintain a professional presence at all times.
- Be mindful of emotional stress during memorial events. Utilize peer support if needed.
- Limit unnecessary radio traffic during procession movement.

5. Emergency Contingencies

- In the event of a secondary incident (MVC, medical emergency, hostile act), notify Command immediately.
- Maintain clear ingress and egress routes at all times.
- Follow established ICS structure and chain of command.

We honor our fallen Trooper by ensuring every responder goes home safely at the end of this operation.

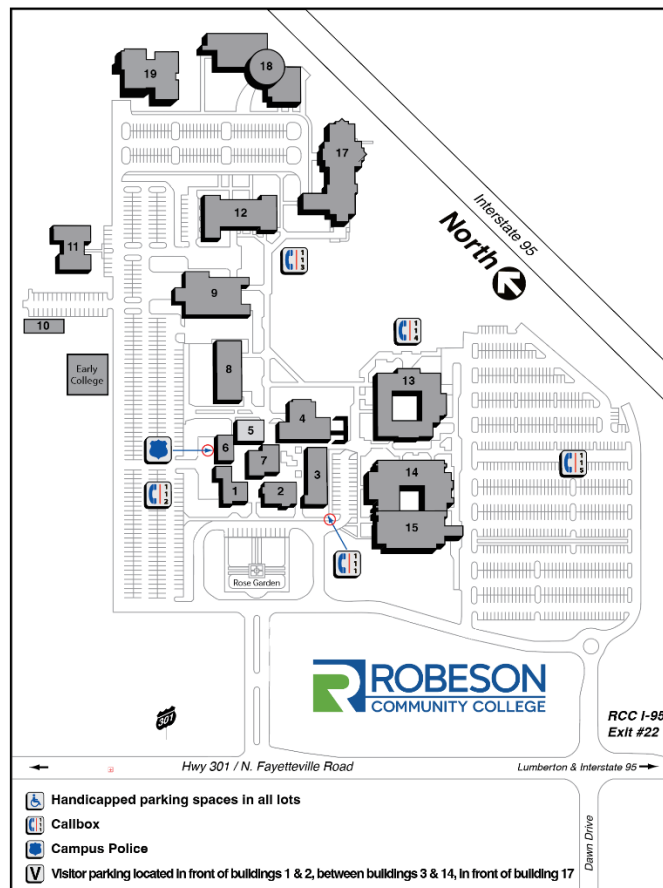

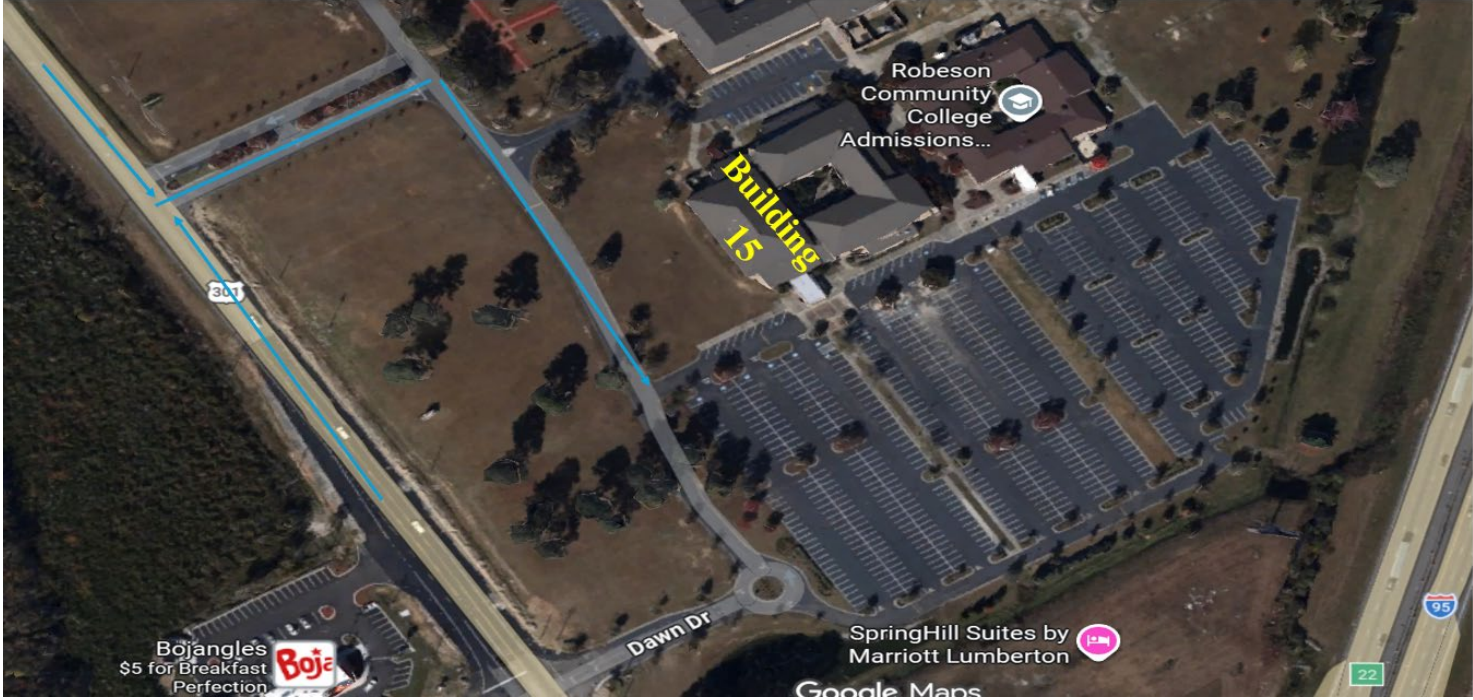
