National Weather Service Wilmington, NC - Issued: 9:09 AM Sunday February 1, 2026

Key Messages:

- A very cold air mass will combine with snowfall and gusty winds to produce dangerous cold conditions through at least early Tuesday morning
- Hazardous travel and impacts to infrastructure will continue for days to come due to snow, melted snow and icy conditions




